

Privacy Policy



Nottingham Society of Artists, referred to as the “Society” from now on, holds personal information about each member, referred to as “You” from now on, that You gave when joining the Society.

What is stored.

The following personal information is kept about Your membership of the Society

- title
- forenames
- surname
- postal address
- telephone number(s)
- email address
- your membership status
- your subscription payment status
- date of joining the Society

The following information may be supplied by You as part of Your Online Gallery. It is all optional.

- the URL of your own personal website
- your CV
- your Artist's Statement
- your qualifications
- a picture of You (known as the “mugshot”)
- pictures in your gallery

The above two groups of information are collectively known as Your “Profile”.

Use made of the personal information

The personal membership information is used for communicating with You about the business of the Society, for recording Your status within the Society, and for managing the annual subscription renewal process.

The information that You provide as part of Your online gallery is displayed alongside images in Your gallery and visible to members of the general public when they visit Your online gallery pages on the Website.

Control You have over Your personal information.

You can edit all of the information in Your profile directly, except for the following items

- your membership status
- your subscription payment status
- date of joining the Society

Control of Visibility of Your Personal Information

You can control whether the following items are hidden from other members, from the general public, or from both.

- postal address
- telephone number(s)
- email address
- the URL of your own personal website

The mugshot is optional but is always displayed in Your gallery if you have uploaded one to Your profile.

What Members of the Public can See

Members of the public can see an index of those members who have created an online gallery and made it public. This index contains Your name and the image from your online gallery that you have selected to be the main image.

Your online gallery would normally not be public until You have completed it and are happy with its contents. Members of the public can see your online gallery (once You make it public) by clicking on Your name in the above index.

The following information is visible to the public in Your online gallery. You can hide all but your forenames and surname.

- forenames
- surname
- telephone number(s)
- the URL of your own personal website

What Members of the Society can see.

Members of the Society can see your name in an index of all the members of the Society. This index is part of the Members Area of the website, not accessible by members of the public. Clicking on Your entry in this index displays the following information about You. You can hide all but Your title, forenames, and surname.

- Your mugshot
- title
- forenames
- surname
- postal address
- telephone number(s)
- email address
- the URL of your own personal website

Retention of Personal Information

If You resign from the Society all of Your personal information, including your online gallery, will be immediately deleted.

If you fail to renew Your subscription within the allowed time period after it becomes due, Your membership is “terminated”. Your personal information, including Your online gallery, is preserved but none of it is visible to either members of the Society or members of the public.

If You subsequently renew Your subscription within a further set period, Your membership is restored and Your personal information reverts to its normal state. If you fail to renew Your subscription within this period Your personal information will be deleted, as if You had resigned.
